CANCELLATION OF DOCUMENT EXCHANGE (DX)

Arising from the decision by Toll Group to move their city based document exchanges away from the CBD of Hobart, Launceston and Burnie, the Supreme Court will no longer use the DX as a collection and delivery service for Court mail.

This change to Court practice will begin from 30 June 2022.

The Court will provide and utilise the following services for mail, other than electronic mail, to and from its Registries:

- 1. By normal mail.
- 2. By registered mail at the request of practitioners. Practitioners are to provide pre-paid Australia Post registered envelopes or satchels, if requesting delivery by registered mail.
- 3. The pigeon hole boxes in the Court Registries that are available at the Supreme Court to all legal practices who nominate their use; and

References to documentation being sent, received and/or returned via the DX, as mentioned in Circulars to Practitioners numbers 10 of 2012; 14 of 2017 and 3 of 2019 are now rescinded.
